


In the above chart it is clearly seen that 75.9% students say that syllabus was covered in the class, while 24.1% do not agree to the same.








In the above chart 62.1% students agreed that teachers approach to teaching was excellent whereas 27.6% feels that teachers approach to teaching was very good.




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.


The above chart indicates that 69% students agreed that every time their performance in assignments were discussed where as 10.3% students say usually their performance in assignments were discussed.

7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.



8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you






9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

In the above chart it is clearly seen that 55% students says teachers informed students about expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes every time, whereas 31 says usually.




From the above chart it's clear that mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to students 31% says usually while 58.6 % says every time.




the chart shows that the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications and 48.3 students says every time while 44.8% are with usually.


13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.




The above chart indicates that 48.3% students say that the teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.




from the above chart we can conclude that Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.52.2% are saying every time while 20.7% says usually.




51.7% students strongly agree on the institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process while 27.6% are selected agree.



51.7% experience that The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences to a great extent.




The above chart indicates that teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities 55.2% strongly agree on it while 20.7% agree on it.


