



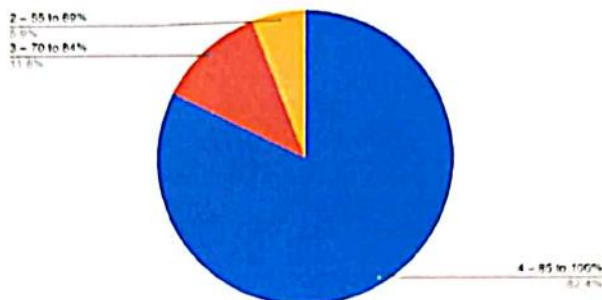

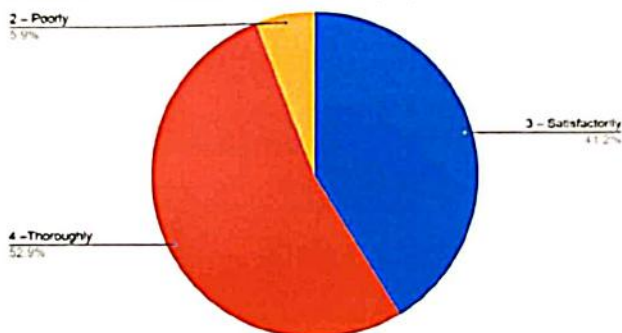

Count of 1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



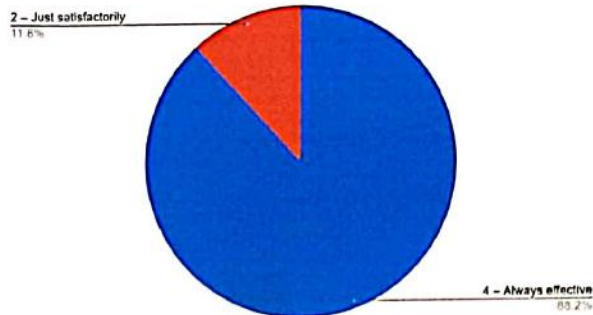
1. In the above chart it is clearly seen that 82.4% students say that syllabus was covered in the class, while 5.9% do not agree to the same.

Count of 2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?



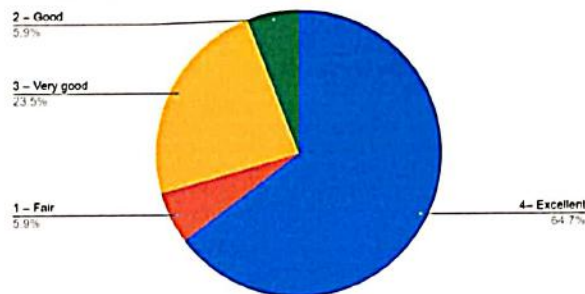

Count of 3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?



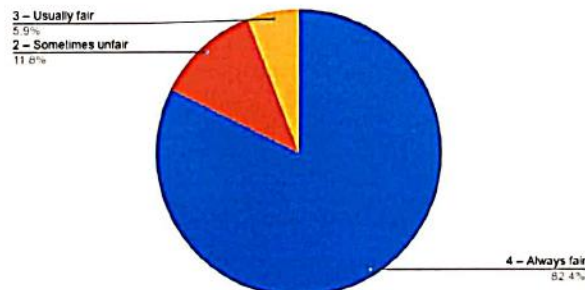
3. As per the above chart 88.2% students responded that teachers were always able to communicate effectively during communication, while 11.8% feel that teachers' communication was just satisfactory.

Count of 4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as



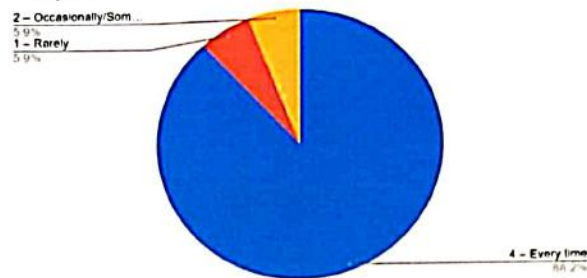
4. In the above chart 64.7% students agreed that teachers approach to teaching was excellent whereas 23.5% feels that teachers approach to teaching was very good.

Count of 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.



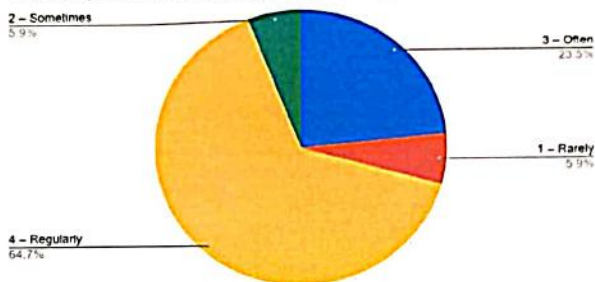

Count of 6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?



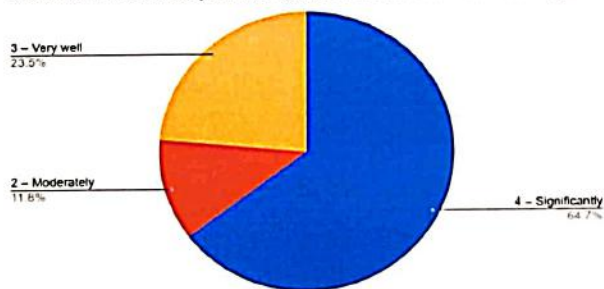
6. The above chart indicates that 88.2% students agreed that every time their performance in assignments were discussed whereas 5.9% students say usually their performance in assignments were discussed.

Count of 7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for stud...



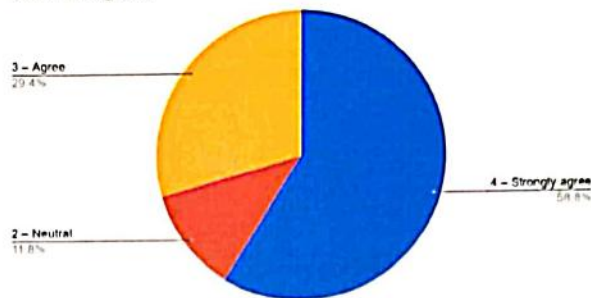

Count of 8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional gr...



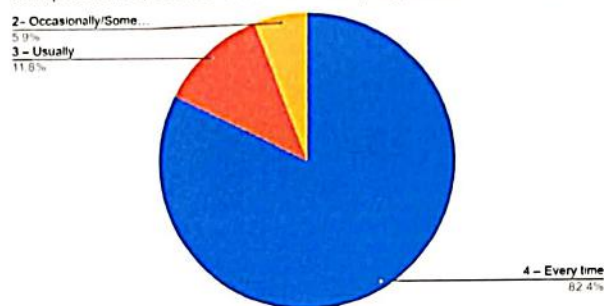

Count of 9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.



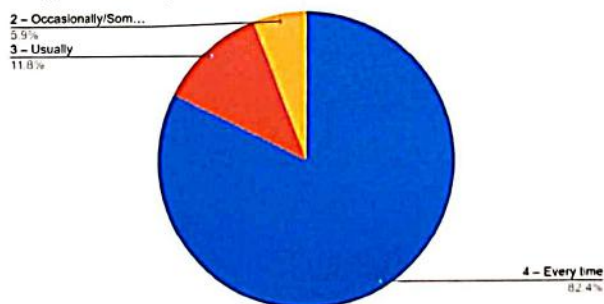

Count of 10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.



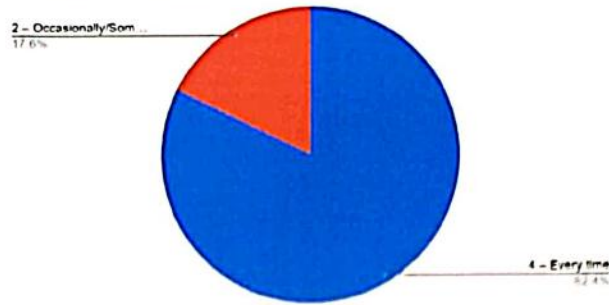

Count of 11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.



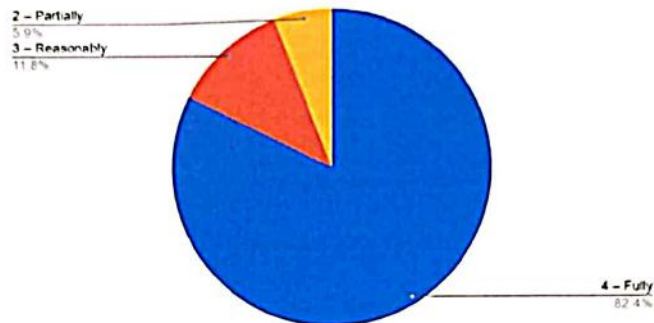
11. From the above chart it's clear that mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to students 11.8% says usually while 82.4 % says every time.

Count of 12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.



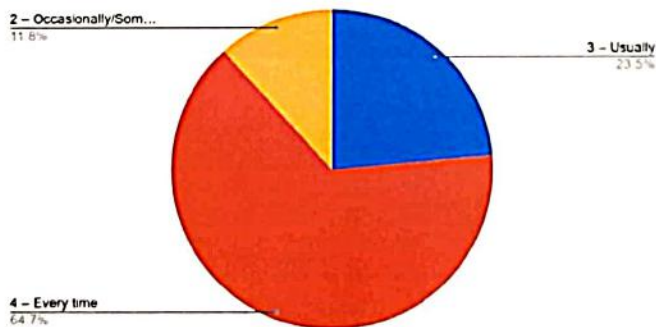
12. The chart shows that the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications and 82.4% students says every time while 17.6% are with occasionally.

Count of 13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.



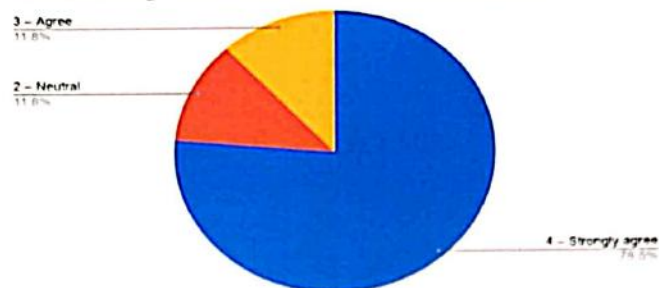
13. The above chart indicates that 82.4% students say that the teachers identify their strengths and encourage them with providing right level of challenges fully, while others 11.8% feels reasonably.

Count of 14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.



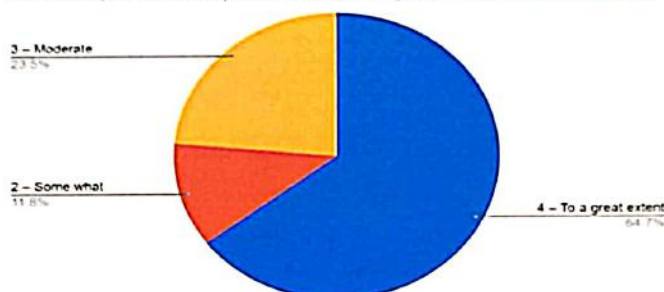
14. From the above chart we can conclude that Teachers are able to identify student weaknesses and help them to overcome them. 64.7% are saying every time while 23.5% says usually.

Count of 15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement o...



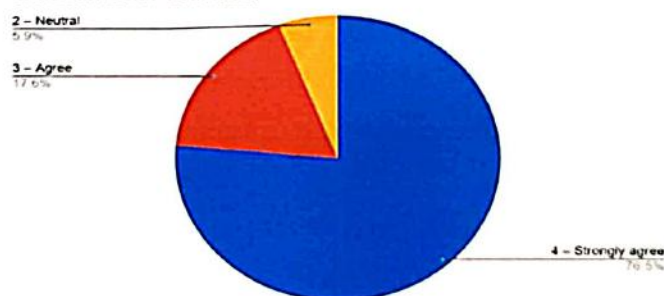

Count of 16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning...



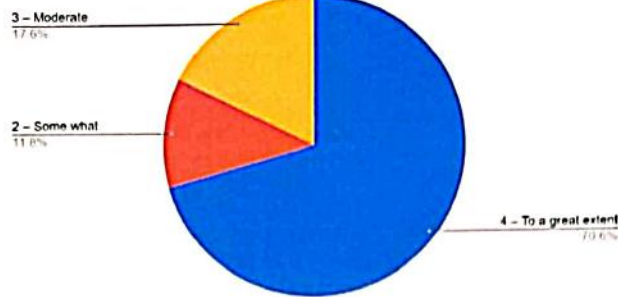

Count of 17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.



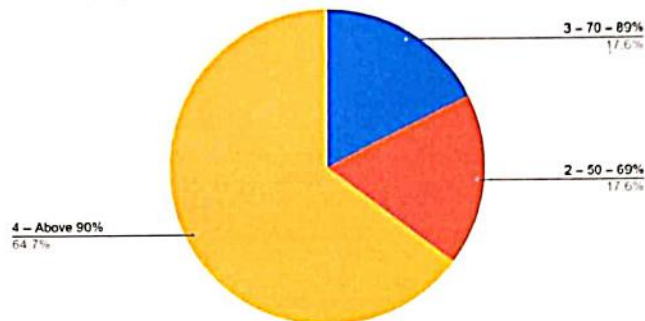
17. The above chart indicates that teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities 76.5% strongly agree on it while 17.6% agree on it.

Count of 18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make...



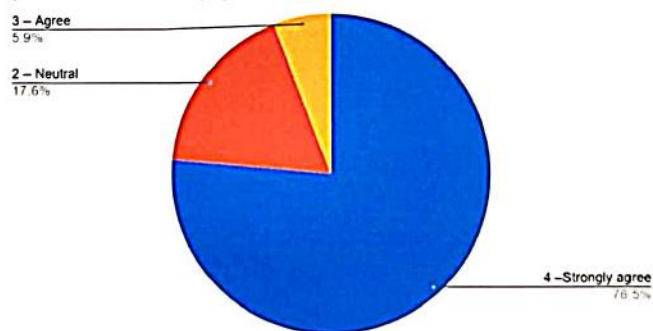
