






1. In the above chart it is clearly seen that 42.9% students say that syllabus was covered in the class, while 5.9% do not agree to the same.






3. As per the above chart 57.1% students responded that teachers were always able to communicate effectively during communication, while 9.5% feel that teachers' communication was just satisfactory.




4. In the above chart 33.3% students agreed that teachers approach to teaching was excellent whereas 19% feels that teachers approach to teaching was very good.






6. The above chart indicates that 38.1% students agreed that every time their performance in assignments were discussed where as 19% students say usually their performance in assignments were discussed.












11. From the above chart it's clear that mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to students 28.6% says usually while 33.3 % says every time.




12. The chart shows that the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications and 38.1% students says every time while 14.3% are with occasionally.




13. The above chart indicates that 38.1% students say that the teachers identify their strengths and encourage them with providing right level of challenges fully, while others 33.3% feels reasonably.




14. From the above chart we can conclude that Teachers are able to identify student weaknesses and help them to overcome them.38.1% are saying every time while 19% says usually.








17. The above chart indicates that teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities 42.9% strongly agree on it while 33.3% agree on it.
