Perspective Plan for M.V.L.U College: A.Y 2021-2022

Our Institution has drafted Perspective Plans for development. Six broad aspects were identified and included in the plan and are as follows : Academics, Research and Extension, Administration, Co and Extra curricular activities, Infrastructure and Financial resources. Gap analysis was also done.

1) Academics :

Where the College is now :

- Four undergraduate programs undertaken are B.Sc(Information Technology), B.Sc(Computer Science), Bachelor of Arts in Multimedia and Mass Communication (BAMMC), B.Sc(Biotechnology).
- Taking into account all the necessary measures, the college began operating in a hybrid mode in 2021–2022.
- Certificate course is introduced which is CEC Certified Software Professional and Digital marketing by BAMMC.
- Passing percentage was fairly good.
- Well equipped library with reading hall.
- Vast collection of text books and newspapers.

Gaps :

- Additional Skill based courses in Biotechnology departments can be introduced.

Perspective Plans :

- Introduction of courses like Android Certification Course, which could not be conducted due to lockdown.
- Providing various courses which will help in increasing their practical knowledge/skills.
- Developing entrepreneurial potential among the students.
- Enhancement of ICT in every classroom.
- Curriculum delivery which will enable students to achieve their learning goals by improving their presentation skills.
- Make available e-resources in the library.



2) Research and Extension :

Where The College is now :

- Good number of around 10 research paper publications from the Computer Science and BAMMC Department students and teachers were done.

Gaps :

- There are fewer students conducting research from other departments.

Perspective plans:

- Encourage other departments to be involved in research and publish their work.

3) Administration :

Where The College is now :

- An Office Superintendent who is also a Certified Public Accountant has been appointed by the College to oversee the administrative employees. He handles day-to-day tax preparation and account writing.
- The smooth functioning of administrative activities is monitored and reviewed by the Director from time to time.
- The college has encouraged the collection of various fees using online mode or through credit/debit cards or UPI payments.
- This gives transparency in the collection of fees and avoids handling large amounts of cash at the counters.
- The office staff also efficiently manages all required compliances with the University of Mumbai and authorities.
- Provide assistance in carrying out a variety of activities:
Co-curricular and extracurricular activities.

- Effective use of technology and soft skills by all staff members.
- Grooming of Junior staff members by Senior staff members.

Cultural:

5) Infrastructure :

Where The College is now :

- There are three smart classrooms on Ground floor, three classrooms on first floor and 10 on second floor, which are fully ventilated.
- Well-equipped Library.
- We have three Computer labs, one Biotechnology laboratory and one Chemistry laboratory.
- Total number of computers available in college 138.
- All departments have computer systems with wifi internet connectivity.
- One spacious Auditorium.
- Fully air-conditioned Admin office.
- One canteen with good quality food.
- Clean washrooms.
- Water purifiers for drinking water.
- Staff rooms in all departments.
- Ground surrounded by greenery.
- Ground with Cricket pitch.
- Lawn tennis court
