POLICY for Laxmi Charitable Trust's Scholarship

Purpose

College established this scholarship in 2019 to provide financial assistance in the form of a scholarship to eligible students from low-income families.

The academic toppers in every course are encouraged by award of cash prizes.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1) The student has not availed any other scholarship.
- 2) The students, who are engaged in full time employment or are repeating the same class or carried any ATKT cannot apply for the scholarship.
- 3) Students must have scored at least 55% marks in the previous examination.
- 4) Students must maintain at least 75% attendance for the current year.
- 5) The annual income of the family is not more than INR 2.0 Lakh from all sources.
- 6) Students must have an Income certificate.
- 7) To encourage academic excellence, top performers are rewarded.

Application Process

- 1) Students must submit the documents listed in the notice to the scholarship committee.
- 2) Applicants are notified of the committee's decision within a specific timeframe.

Disbursement and Accountability

- 1) Approved funds are disbursed based on the documents submitted by the applicant.
- 2) The allocation of funds is entirely up to the college. The college administration has the ultimate authority to determine the disbursement amount.

Review and Evaluation

- 1) The effectiveness of this policy is evaluated on a regular basis to ensure that it is in line with the college's research goals and priorities.
- 2) Feedback from recipients and stakeholders are collected to identify areas for improvement.

Amendments

This policy may be amended as needed by the college administration, with proper notification to all stakeholders.

Implementation

This policy will get implemented immediately upon approval by the college authorities.

POLICY for Financial Assistance in Research

Purpose

The college initiates financial assistance in research to promote awareness of research among faculty and students. In 2022, the college introduced this to strengthen undergraduate students' interest in research.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1) Students must be enrolled in a degree program at Sheth L. U. J. & Sir M. V. College.
- 2) Teacher must be employed as a full-time faculty member at Sheth L. U. J. & Sir M. V. College.
- 3) Financial assistance will be given to the author whose first affiliation is Sheth L. U. J. & Sir M. V. College of Arts, Science, and Commerce.
- 4) The paper must be published in the UGC care list or a peer-reviewed registered journal.

Application Process

- 1) Applicants (both students and teachers) must submit a payment receipt, paper acceptance mail & published paper certificate.
- 2) Applicants are notified of the committee's decision within a specific timeframe.

Disbursement and Accountability

- 1) Approved funds are disbursed based on the documents submitted by the applicant.
- 2) The allocation of funds is entirely up to the college. The college administration has the ultimate authority to determine the disbursement amount.

Review and Evaluation

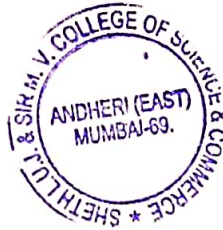
POLICY for KUTUMBA - Private Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria

- 2) The students, who are engaged in full time employment or are repeating the same class or carried any ATKT cannot apply for the scholarship.
- 3) Students must have scored at least 55% marks in the previous examination.
- 4) Students must maintain at least 75% attendance for the current year.
- 5) Students must have an Income or EBC certificate.
