1. Breast Cancer Awareness Seminar:

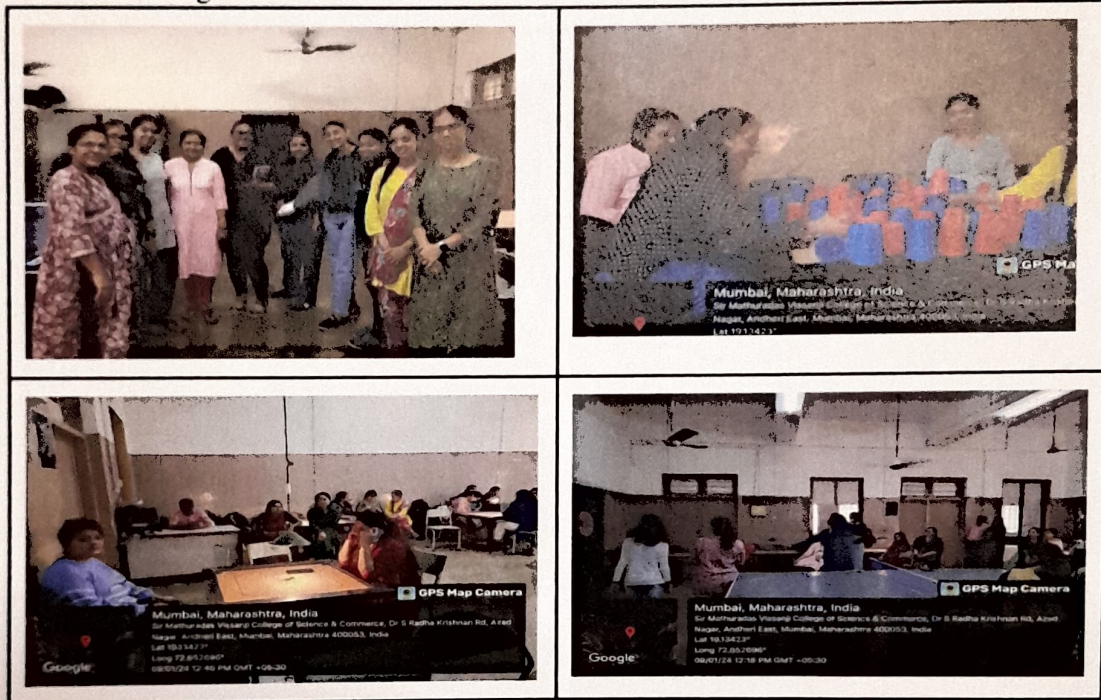

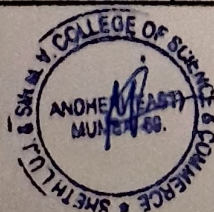
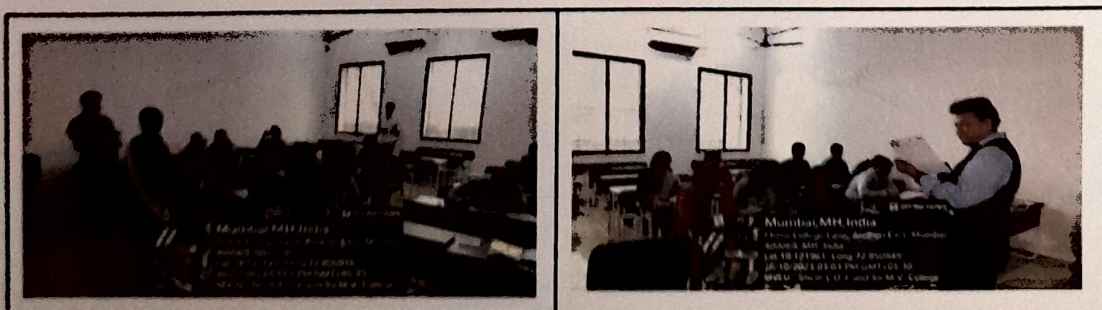
2. Female Staff Recreational Event- MVLU & Chinai College

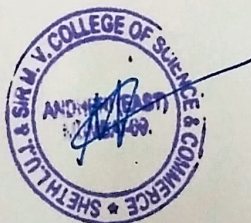
2. Staff Recreational Event

1. POSTER MAKING COMPETITION ON GENDER EQUITY

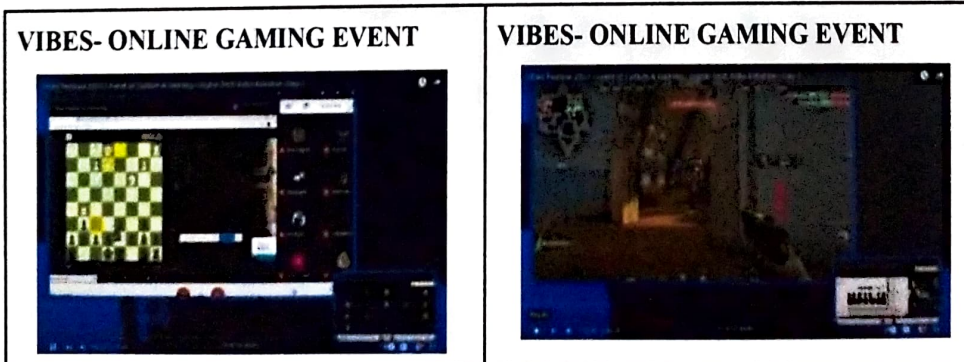

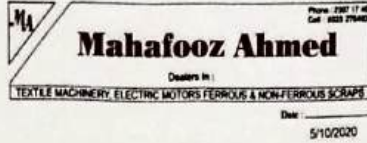
3. Commitment towards "Green Healing" (CGH)

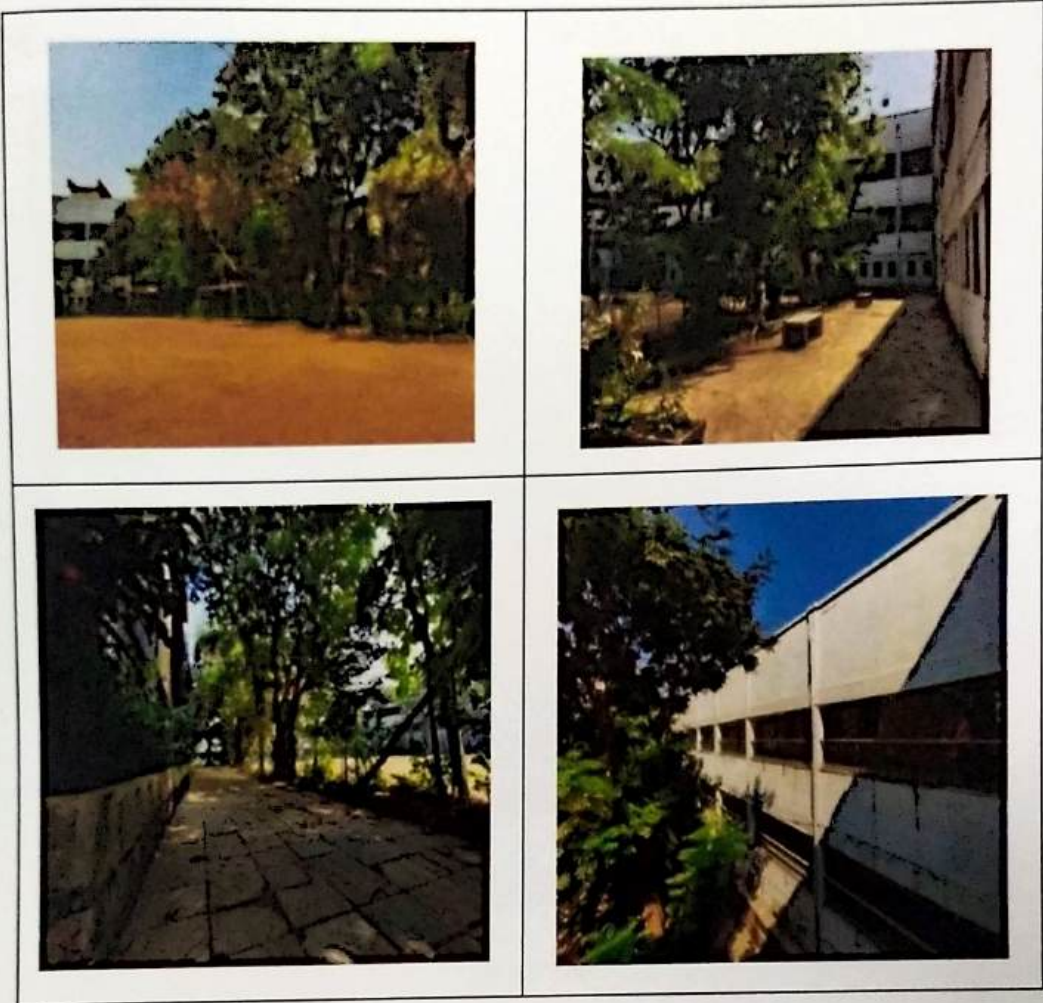
