

Brief Report: CA Pravin Kakade of NPK & Co LLP discussed how to save money, prepare for different periods of life, and profit from investing in various classes of investment. He provided examples from daily life to explain topics for different types of funds. The speaker emphasised the importance of long-term investing in the post-pandemic age, encouraging guests to invest in secure schemes such as PPF, EPF, Equity, ELSS, and others.

- Heuristic function
- Where:
 - $h(x)$: Forward cost, from the current state to the goal state.
 - $g(x)$: Backward cost, from the root state or initial state.
 - Path cost is low.
