

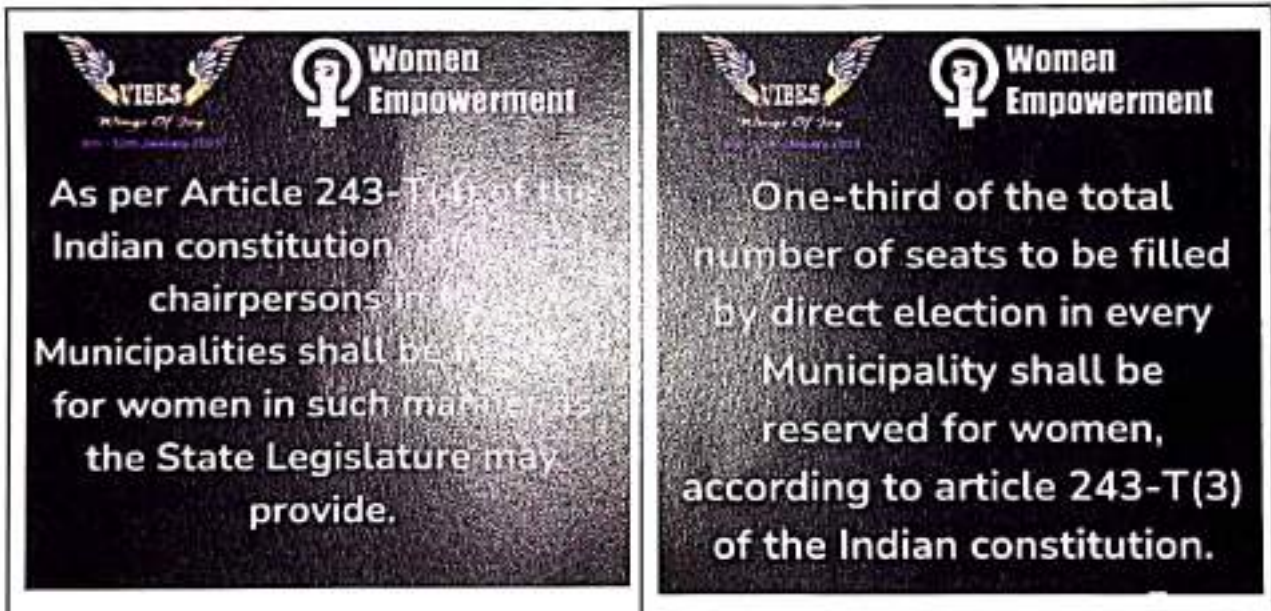
3.3 - Extension Activities 2022-2023

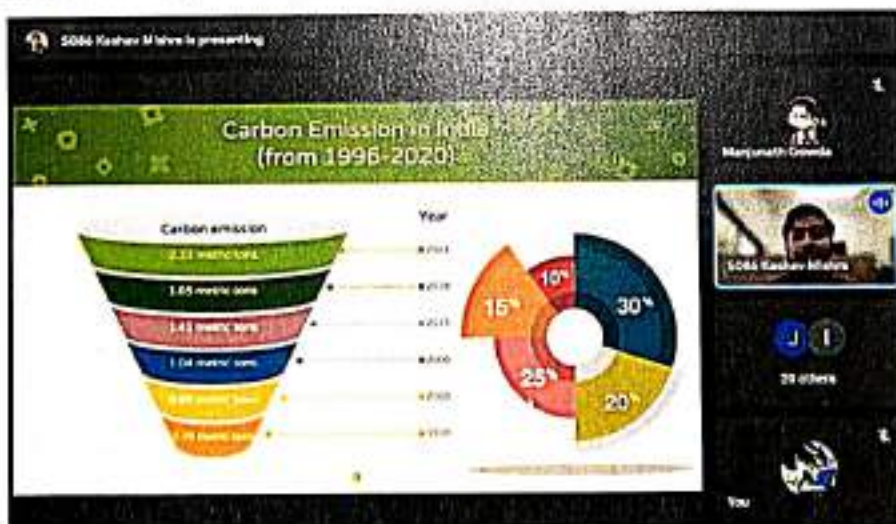
IT department : Green-Tech Intercollegiate Power Point Presentation Competition

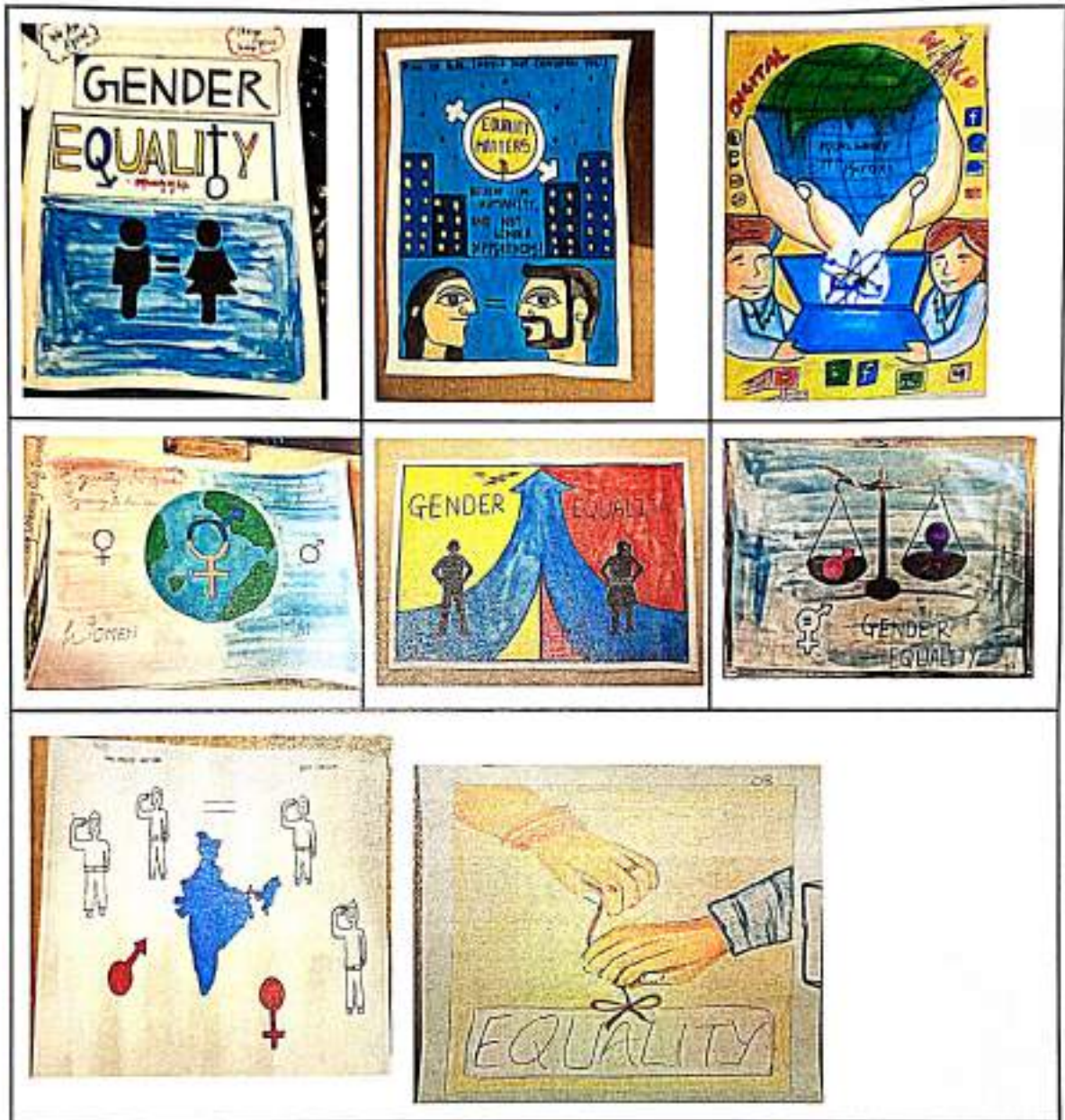

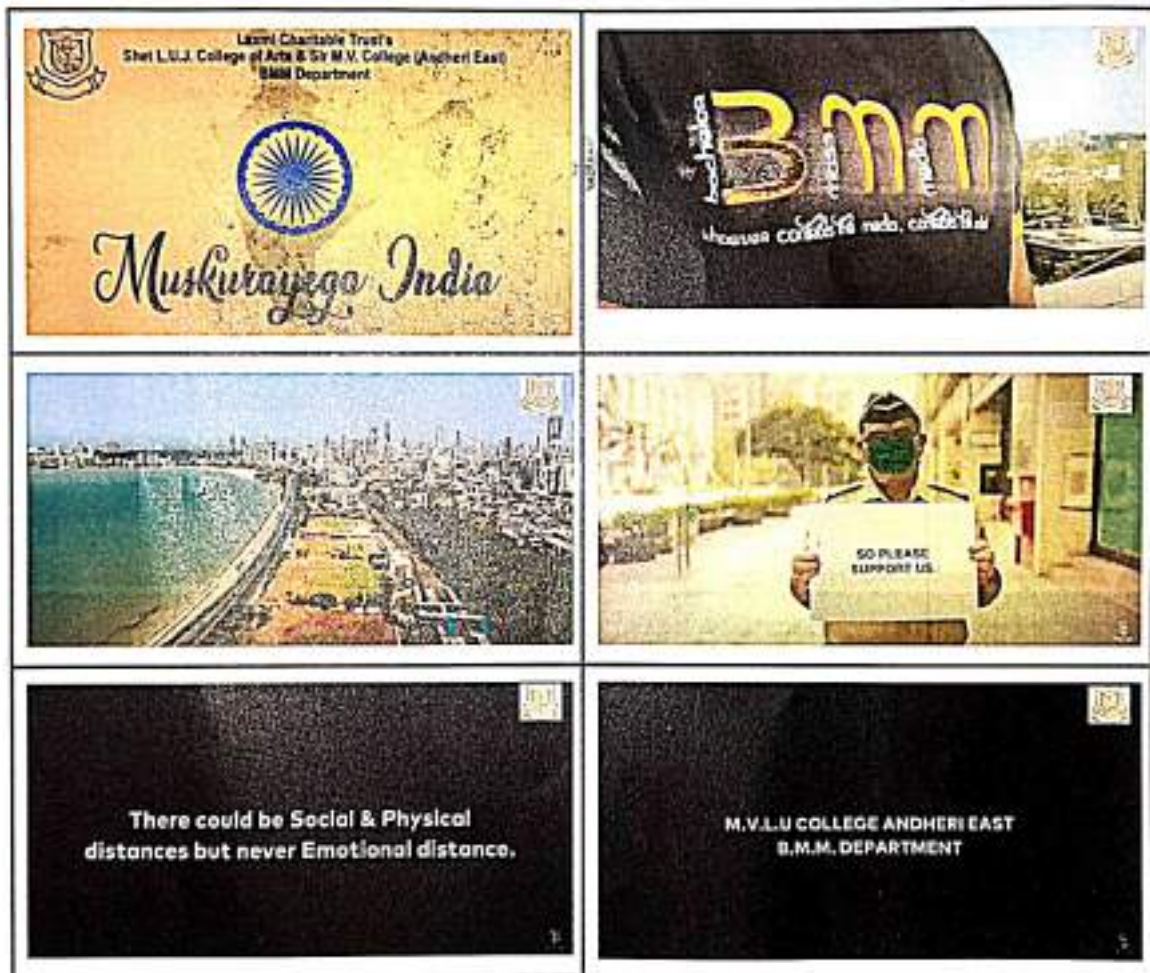
