Brief Report: The Industrial visit aimed to teach students about thermal power plant working. The Adani-Dahanu Thermal Power Station (ADTPS), a 250 MW power plant in the nation, has been acknowledged for its technological innovation, high performance, and environmental sustainability. The plant has integrated management systems and has received certifications for quality management, environmental management, occupational health, and safety assessment studies, social accountability management, information security management, energy management, and ADTPS coal testing laboratory accreditation. Students visited various sections, including imported coal, quality checking, actual operation, turbines, exciter, boiler, ash handling plant, coal handling plant, conveyor belt, and 220 MV distribution. The plant has the highest chimney in Asia. At the end, after filling out the feedback form, students and staff received visit certificates.
